## UPDATED STATEMENT OF WORK

### Social Media

Moonlight Coalition students participating in WIOA are eligible and encouraged to participate in a two-part workshop that focuses on social media and internet privacy with an emphasis on employer and employee rights. Participants will explore topics such as internet branding, user security, data analytics, right to free speech, and legal hiring and firing relative to social media and internet use on and off the job. Each participant will be offered an opportunity to bring devices to class for a guided tutorial on clearing device history and securing personal information.

**Virtual Tutoring**


Since the issuance of remote learning mandates from the State of Illinois, Moonlight Coalition has offered virtual tutoring to its students in place of on-site tutoring. The return of on-site tutoring provides students the opportunity to resume their GED preparation in a traditional manner. For students who choose to continue with virtual tutoring or to combine both on-site and virtual, Moonlight offers learning hours and tutors to students throughout the week in all subject areas. Hours can be arranged between student and tutor, allowing flexibility in scheduling as well as increase in tutorial time. Additionally, students who elect to utilize virtual tutoring gain experience with technology tools that can be applied in other learning and employment settings.

**Location**

The on-site location for GED tutoring will take place at Logan Recreation Center. The relocation from Proctor Recreation Center to Logan Recreation Center is due to COVID-19. The Park District is currently limiting the programs offered in a single facility to adhere to safety precautions related to COVID-19. Due to the relocation, rent for the WIOA program has been added to the budget request in the amount of \$1,667 per month for 12 months.
